The webinar's link will be sent 2/3 days prior to the parents through their registered email address. If interested, parents can register for the webinar and participate.

Why?

IPSATIVE ASSESSMENTS

As ipsative assessments go, students can compare their current performance with previous performance(s) as we release round-wise marks for both the Levels in their student portal. From morphemes to pragmatics -this self-referential periodical assessment help them gauge their performance and improvement.



FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS
