



## OFFLINE NATIONAL LEVEL (L3) EXAM - GUIDELINES

### Important Instructions

- The Exam has only **12 rounds**.
- **Each question carries 1 mark. Total of 100 marks.**
- The duration of the Exam is **one hour** only.
- A short Tie exam will be conducted for the toppers of this Main paper on a later date, to decide the prize winners.
- Write your particulars (in the first page) in CAPITAL LETTERS.
- Have your **2023 – 2024's SPIN ID** (the 12 digit reg. no. - eg. 23XXXXXXXXXX) along with your other particulars before starting the exam.
- You can get your **School Code** from your invigilator.
- You are allowed to use a blank paper, pen/pencil to work out (if needed).
- You can use pen/pencil; however answering with a pencil will help in correcting, if need be.
- Follow the **instructions in every Round** to correctly answer questions under it. Each Round will also have an **example question** answered for you to understand how to answer. Just follow the same.
- Your Round 1 words will be given as dictation by your invigilator – listen carefully and write the words.
- Rely only on your preparation and your brain to complete this timed exam successfully. We expect your **utmost honesty** and the school's fullest cooperation in this regard.
- If you complete the paper before the allotted time, you can check and re-check your answers and remain calm till the hour elapses (refrain from asking for "help" and offering to "help")

ROUND 7 – FORM THE CORRECT SENTENCE – 5 QUESTIONS * 1 MARK	= 5 MARKS
ROUND 8 – PHONETICS– 10 QUESTIONS * 1 MARK	= 10 MARKS
ROUND 9 – READING COMPREHENSION– 5 QUESTIONS * 1 MARK	= 5 MARKS
ROUND 10 – CROSSWORD– 10 QUESTIONS * 1 MARK	= 10 MARKS
ROUND 11 – WORD WEAVING– 10 QUESTIONS * 1 MARK	= 10 MARKS
ROUND 12 – COMPOUND WORDS AND KINDS/TYPES OF WORDS– 10 QUESTIONS * 1 MARK	= 10 MARKS
